Here, we are pioneers. YWCA Greater Cincinnati, the fifth association in the United States, was founded in 1868 to address the needs of working women. Our downtown historic headquarters was built in 1926 and was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1982. In communities big and small, our work keeps us in four counties: Hamilton, Clermont, Adams, and Brown.

YWCA Greater Cincinnati serves women, men, and children through programs and services focused in three key areas:

- Racial Justice & Inclusion
- Empowerment & Economic Advancement
- Health & Safety

We operate the only domestic violence shelters in Southwest Ohio—available 24-hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year. YWCA is 75 team members strong, working to empower more than 12,000 people every year.
